Current opening for a Behavior Analyst at the Texana BTTC Outreach Program providing behavior analysis services for children and adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities including autism. Services are provided primarily through an outpatient clinic and include functional analyses; development, implementation and evaluation of behavior intervention programs; monitoring effects of assessment and intervention programs; consultation to schools and families; and staff/family training. The Behavior Analyst provides extensive hands-on behavior intervention directly with the child and parents. Clients present a variety of challenges including lack of skill acquisition, physical and verbal aggression, elopement, excessive self-stimulatory behavior, and self-injurious behaviors. Primarily Monday-Friday 8-5 with some weekends and evenings scheduled in advance. The BTTC Outreach Clinic is located in Rosenberg, TX. Minimum of Masters in behavior analysis or related field. Must be BCBA or eligible within 6 months.
