
### **Poster Submission Information**

- Poster submissions are due by Monday, February 26, 2024.
- Presenting authors will be notified by Friday, March 8, 2024, of their acceptance or rejection.
- Each year at the annual conference, students, faculty, and practitioners showcase their research in a poster session. **Posters at TxABA must be related to behavior analysis and present research.** Poster submissions unrelated to the discipline or not showcasing research will not be accepted. The poster session at the 39th Annual TxABA Conference will be held Friday, April 12, 2024, from 5:30-7:30 pm. Please review the following information before submitting.
- Poster presenters are required to be a **member of TxABA** and **register for the 39th annual conference.** Anyone who has not registered for the conference or doesn't have a TxABA membership by February 26, 2024 will be automatically dropped from the poster session.
  - If you are volunteering to cover registration, applied for a student scholarship, or have free conference registration through other means (track coordinator, presenter, committee member, council member, etc.)- this will be checked in our system and you do not need to contact us.
- Posters should be smaller than 46" H x 46" W to fit on the provided poster boards/space
- Have email addresses and names of additional authors. If the author has a Behavior Live account, please use the email address associated with the account to pull in their information.
- The poster session is in-person only, there is not a virtual option for posters.
- Poster submission requires submitting your current data, in-progress data sets are okay for submission but should be complete when
  presented at the conference
- Communication regarding the poster will be sent to the email address associated with the Behavior Live account of the individual submitting the poster; we recommend the presenter is the individual who submits the poster
- If you need any accommodation, please enter them in the special requests field and a TxABA member will reach out to you.
- The annual student poster competition will be held during the 2024 poster session. Entering this competition requires no additional submission material beyond a normal poster submission. Entries are required to be a **student member of TxABA** by February 26, 2024, to be entered into the student competition. If you are not a student member already, <u>please visit here for information</u> on becoming a student member.
- Each poster in the student competition will be assigned several poster sessions judges who are in charge of interacting with the poster competitor and scoring the poster and its presentation. Judges, made up of TxABA members and presenters, review each student entry and select two posters for Best Student Poster Award.
- These judges will use a scoring sheet similar to this one that was used for the 2019 poster session. Please note that the precise format of this scoring sheet is subject to change.
- There are typically 2 winners of the poster competition each year. The winners of the student poster competition are awarded \$200.
- If you are a student member and wish to be part of the 2024 Student Poster Competition, please type Student Poster Competition, the name of your university, and the supervising professor for the research you are presenting in the special requests field.



  membership by February 26, 2024 will be automatically dropped from the poster session.
  - o If you are volunteering to cover registration, applied for a student scholarship, or have free conference registration through other means (track coordinator, presenter, committee member, council member, etc.)- this will be checked in our system and you do not need to contact us.
- Posters should be smaller than 36" H x 48" W to fit on the provided poster boards/space.
- Have email addresses and names of additional authors. If the author has a Behavior Live account, please use the email address associated with the account to pull in their information
- The poster session is in-person only, there is not a virtual option for posters.
- Poster submission requires submitting your current data, in-progress data sets are okay for submission but should be complete when presented at the conference
- Communication regarding the poster will be sent to the email address associated with the Behavior Live account of the individual submitting the poster; we recommend the presenter is the individual who submits the poster
- If you need any accommodation, please enter them in the special requests field and a TxABA member will reach out to you.

The annual student poster competition will be held during the 2024 poster session. Entering this competition requires no additional submission material beyond a normal poster submission. Entries are required to be a **student member of TxABA** by February 26, 2024, to be entered into the student competition. Each poster in the student competition will be assigned several poster sessions judges who are in charge of interacting with the poster competitor and scoring the poster and its presentation. Judges, made up of TxABA members and presenters, review each student entry and select two posters for Best Student Poster Award.

These judges will use a scoring sheet similar to this one that was used for the 2019 poster session. Please note that the precise format of this scoring sheet is subject to change.


